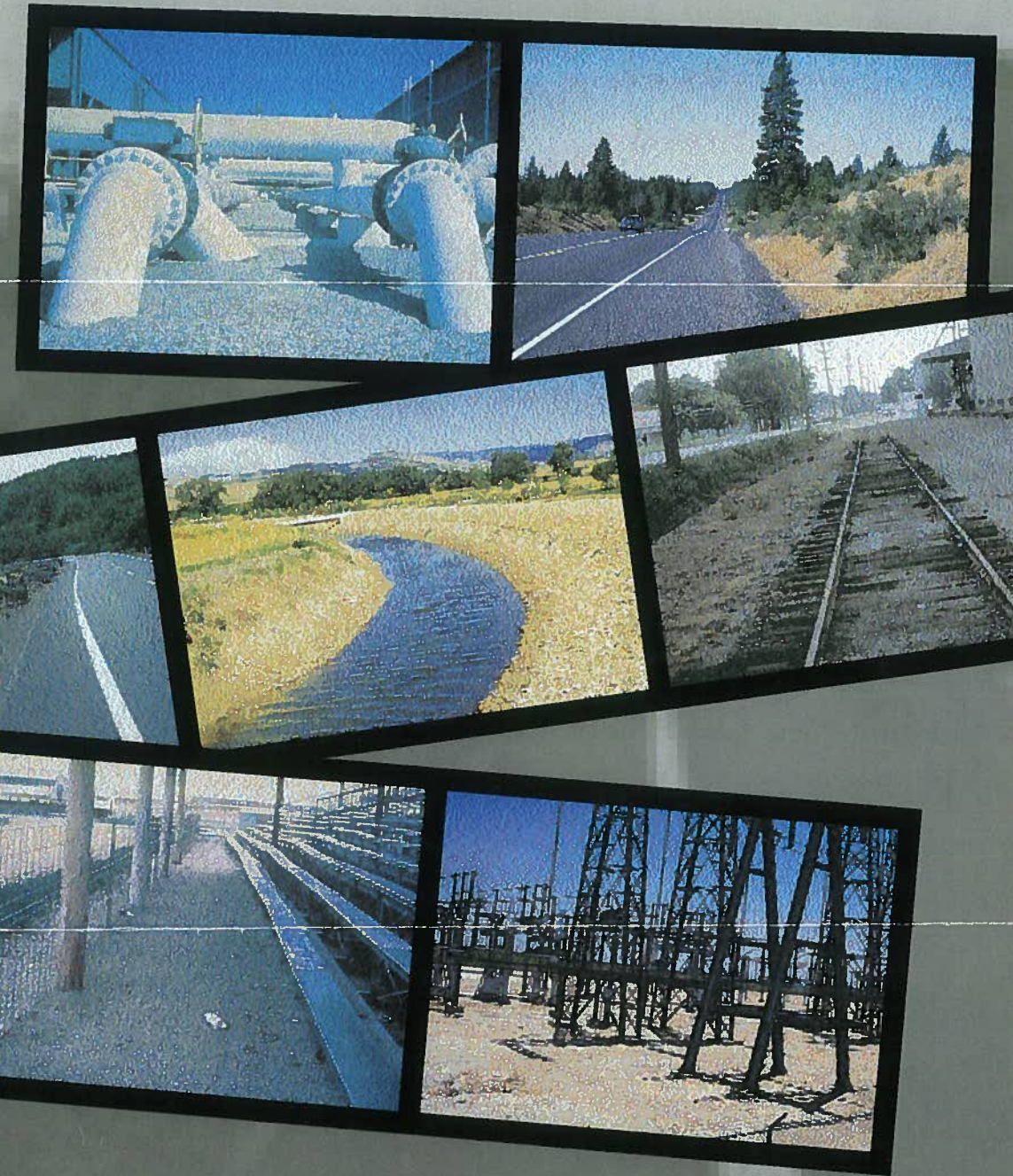


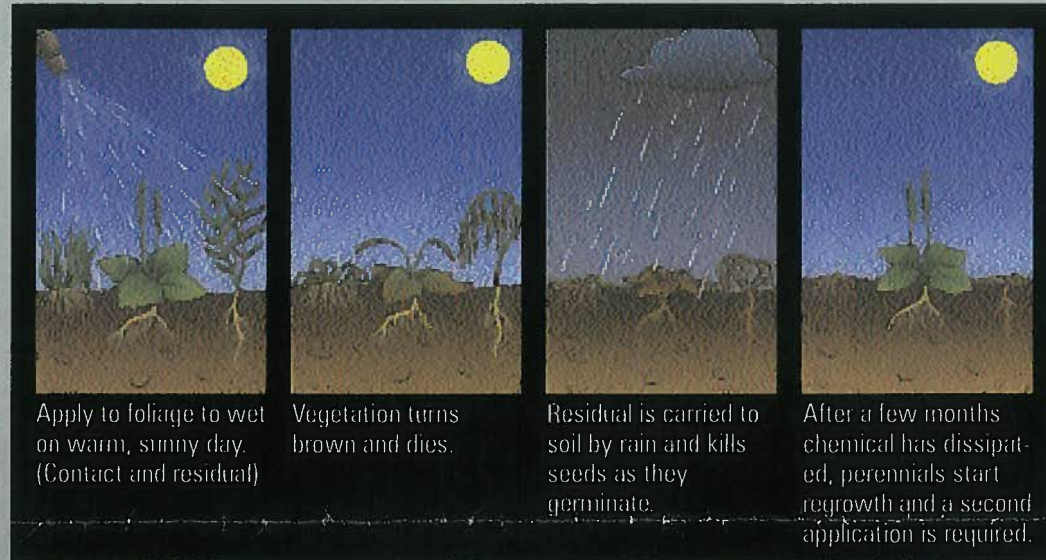

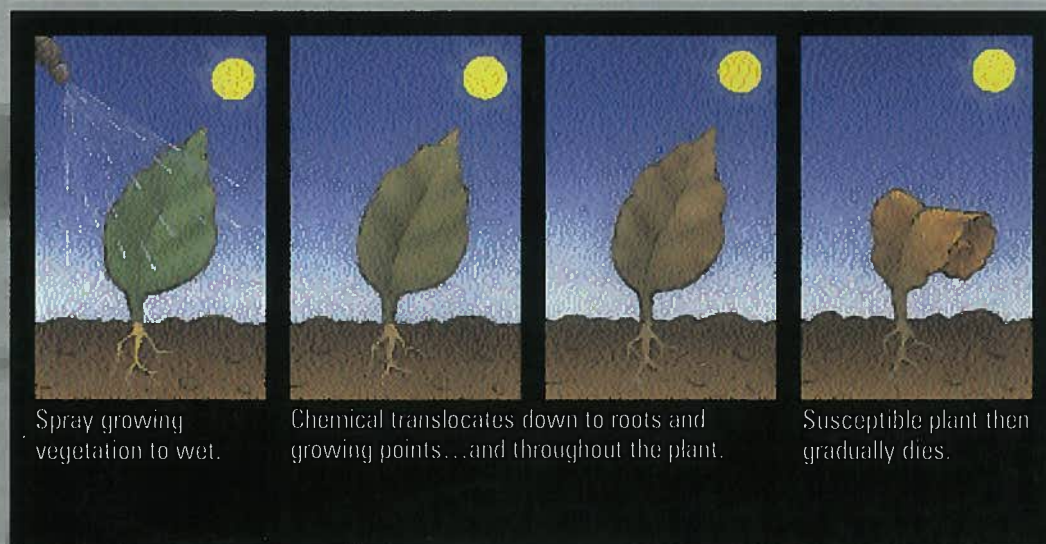

How a short-term treatment works



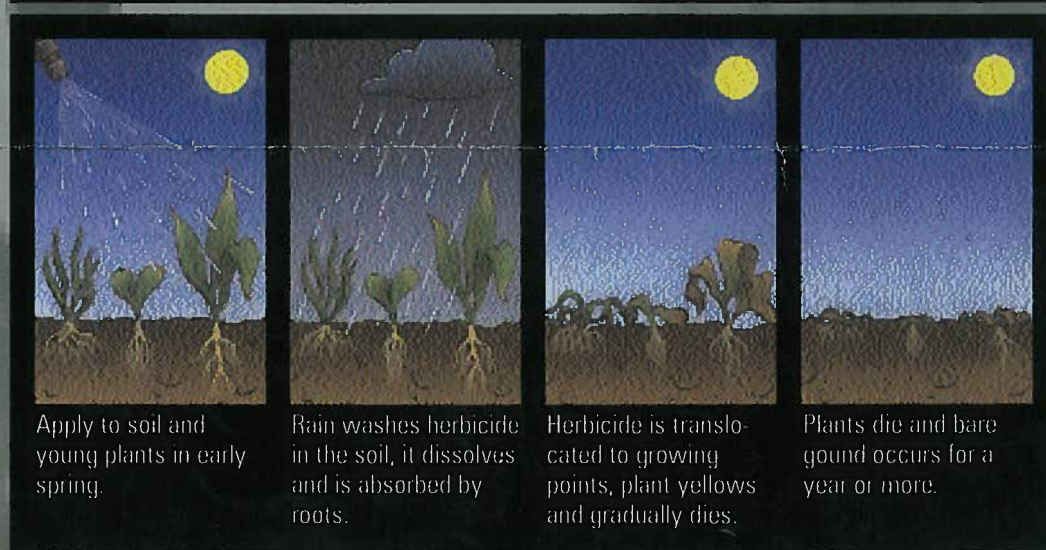
Apply to foliage to wet on warm, sunny day. (Contact and residual)
Vegetation turns brown and dies.
Residual is carried to soil by rain and kills seeds as they germinate.
After a few months chemical has dissipated, perennials start regrowth and a second application is required.

How a foliage systemic works



Spray growing vegetation to wet.
Chemical translocates down to roots and growing points... and throughout the plant.
Susceptible plant then gradually dies.

How a non-selective residual works



Apply to soil and young plants in early spring.
Rain washes herbicide in the soil, it dissolves and is absorbed by roots.
Herbicide is translocated to growing points, plant yellows and gradually dies.
Plants die and bare ground occurs for a year or more.

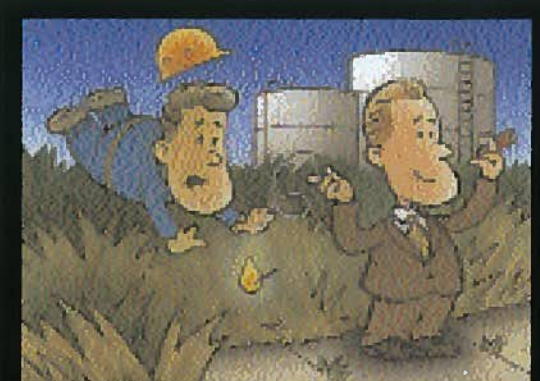

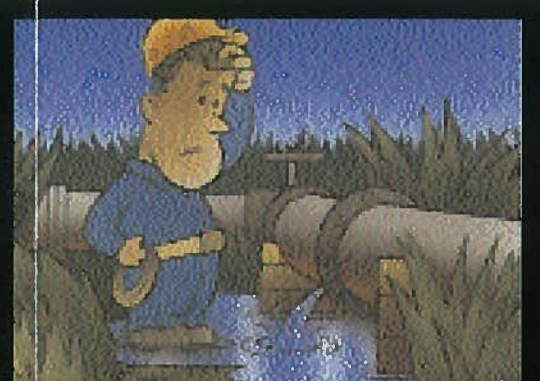
12 reasons why it pays to control weeds



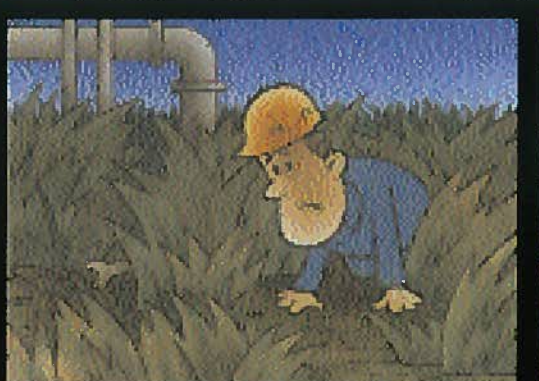
Weeds create fire hazards. Dead and dried weed growth is highly flammable.



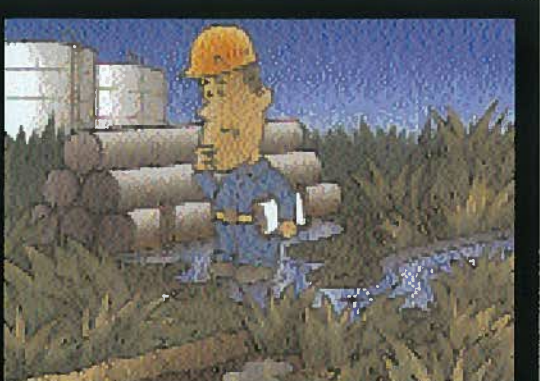
Weeds create employee working hazards. Some plants are poisonous; some have offensive pollen; green growth under foot can cause slipping; vines can cause tripping; visibility is restricted.



Weeds increase metal corrosion and wood decay by holding moisture.



Weeds can cause increased loss of tools and materials on outside work.



Weeds cause water damage to materials, buildings, and property by obstructing the flow of water in drainage ditches and culverts.

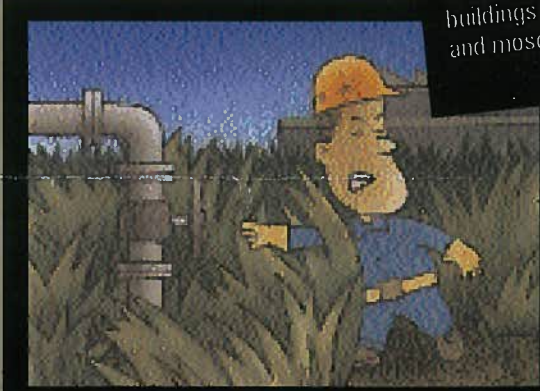
Weeds establish breeding places around buildings for rodents and insects such as ticks and mosquitos.



Weeds are a source of noxious plants and insects for agricultural neighbors.



Weeds create traffic hazards by obstructing driver vision, particularly at road crossings.



Weeds impair inspection and maintenance of railroad facilities, pipeline installations, security fences, electric substations, pumping stations, etc.



Weeds (woody plants—"brush") cause interruptions to telephone and electric service. Falling trees or limbs pull down conductors. Tall growing bushes cause short circuits by coming in contact with conductors.



Weeds cause aggravation and added work time. Job efficiency on routine or emergency outside work, especially at night or in rain, is impaired by weed or brush growth.
